

MANAGE NOTIFICATIONS/COMMUNITY DIGESTS

Settings can be updated within your account to change preferences on how you get updates from the online community.

1. Click the **Welcome, (your name)** area at the top right of your screen.
2. Click **Account + Settings**.
3. Click **Information & Settings**.
4. Update any general notification settings as preferred by selecting or deselecting on/off boxes next to the setting.
5. Scroll to the bottom of the page.
6. Update your time zone.
7. Select or deselect the boxes to represent your digest email preferences.
 - a. **Forum Digest** = An email of any recent activity of Forums you are subscribed to.
 - b. **Daily Updates** = A daily email of the latest community activity. If you have logged into your account in the past 24 hours, the daily digest will not be sent.
 - c. **Weekly Updates** = A weekly email with the latest activities in the community will be sent on Mondays.



Membership Dues Change

The membership dues for IAIP are reviewed annually and adjusted per the Consumer Price Index (CPI). The CPI for 2022 was 7.9%. As a result, the international dues will increase for the 2023-2024 membership year effective July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024 as follows:


Active Member and Member-at-Large: \$120.50
Retired Member: \$60.25
Student Member: \$90.50
Retired Lifetime Member: \$422.00

Members will receive renewal notices reflecting the change to international dues for the 2023-2024 membership year.


REGION VII - 2023 REGIONAL CAMPAIGN
